Context and Environment

The British Council in Colombia is a largely UK government grant funded non-for-profit organisation. Colombia is an important commercial, cultural, and educational partner for the UK, and we need to increase the impact of our operation locally. In Colombia, the British Council works mainly in English, Education and Arts.

The English Programmes (EP) division manages a portfolio of large-scale and local projects, providing a variety of consultancy services, teacher training, and mentoring activities for government schools. These initiatives are supported through International Cooperation agreements with ministries and local education authorities.

Purpose

To lead the technical implementation of key strategic components as part of a project with the Local Education Authority of Bogotá. This includes:

Activity 1: Diagnosis – Liaising with an evaluation team to conduct a thorough assessment in up to 320 government schools in Bogotá.

Activity 2: Baseline English Levels - Establishing benchmark levels of English proficiency.

Activity 3: Documents and Materials – Leading the creation of documents and educational materials.

Main Responsibilities

Activity 1: Diagnosis

- Work together with the evaluation team (senior researchers, sampler, data analyst, experts in quantitative analysis, and index design) and the data collection team.
- Oversee the technical implementation of activities conducted by the evaluation and data collection teams. This includes designing the conceptual model, developing data collection instruments, conducting in-person data collection at schools, analysing the data, and diagnosing the results.

Activity 2: Baseline English Levels

- Support the Operations Manager and the evaluation team in preparing the implementation plan and timeline; selecting the sample of students and teachers; communicating the selections to schools, teachers, parents, and students; administering tests to both students and teachers; and analysing the collected data.

Activity 3: Documents and Materials

- Support the Operations Manager and selected consultants in preparing two key documents that will inform further decisions on implementation:
 - A document that provides comparative descriptions of the various artificial intelligence solutions offered to the Local Education Authority to enhance English language learning and teaching.
 - A document that offers recommendations on the integration of technologies into the learning and teaching process, with specific guidance on protecting the rights, wellbeing, and safeguarding of children and young people who may use these technological tools.
- Lead the technical review of both documents.
- Liaise with an external team during the design of an AI-based tool to support English teachers in lesson planning.

General Responsibilities

- Support the design of implementation plans, including detailed guidelines, tools, and protocols.
- Support the delivery of training sessions as required.
- Prepare reports on the implementation, risks, and impact of various activities.
- Conduct technical reviews of documents and teaching/learning materials produced for the project.

- Oversee and advise on the pedagogical follow-up for planning and delivery of assigned activities, in accordance with guidelines provided by the British Council and its partner.
- Lead and provide guidance on the design and reporting of deliverables and products specified by the programme.
- Serve as a liaison between internal and external stakeholders for the design and implementation of project.
- Participate in technical and administrative meetings as required by the project.
- Provide professional support for managing calls for participation and registration processes in alignment with the actions developed with the Local Education Authority of Bogotá.
- Assist in the preparation and organisation of meetings related to project implementation and delivery, as guided by the British Council and its partner.
- Complete all mandatory training provided by the British Council and adhere to the protocols and regulations when interacting with underaged students and vulnerable adults.
